NPN seeks to give Native American Professionals in the Buffalo-Niagara region an opportunity to network in a fun and relaxed environment.

NACS helps co-host the Native Professional Network on a quarterly basis in venues around the region with corporate and foundation partners along with sponsors for each of the events.
